Anastasi argues that vocal continuity, made possible by biological constraints that mark its anatomical and physiological aspects, places

human beings in a relationship of semiotic continuity with non-human communication forms. In turn, this enables us to better describe the phylogenetic processes which determined the development of musical behaviours in the Sapiens, as well as the way in which such behaviours interwove with the expressive vocality of the animal world.
